Before Reading	<p><i>Have a look through the book-</i></p> <p>What do you think might happen in this book? Why do you think that?</p> <p>What kind of things might you do on a snowy day?</p>
During Reading	<p>Page 9 What time of the day was it? How do you know?</p> <p>Page 11 Who had piled up the snow? Why did they?</p> <p>Page 15 What might Peter have found in the snow? Why do you think that?</p> <p>Page 29 Why do you think Peter had a bath after he got home? (eg. Because he would have been very cold from playing in the snow.)</p>
After Reading	<p>Questions</p> <p>1) Retell the story. What happened in the beginning, middle and end?</p> <p>2) Do you think that Peter had played out in the snow before? (eg. Yes, because he knew how to make a snow angel. He was allowed to play out by himself.
